Following a Travelers' Mass on Monday morning, members departed for home.



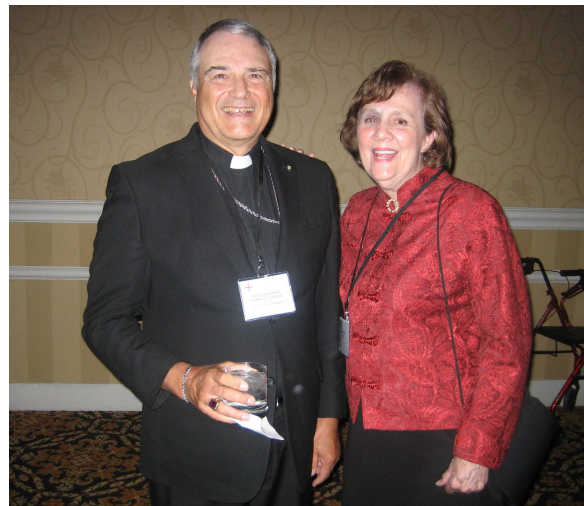

NEW HOLY LAND MASS REQUEST FORMS AVAILABLE

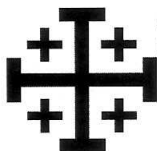
