LIEUTENANCY ESTABLISHES HOLY LAND LEGACY GUARDIAN PROGRAM

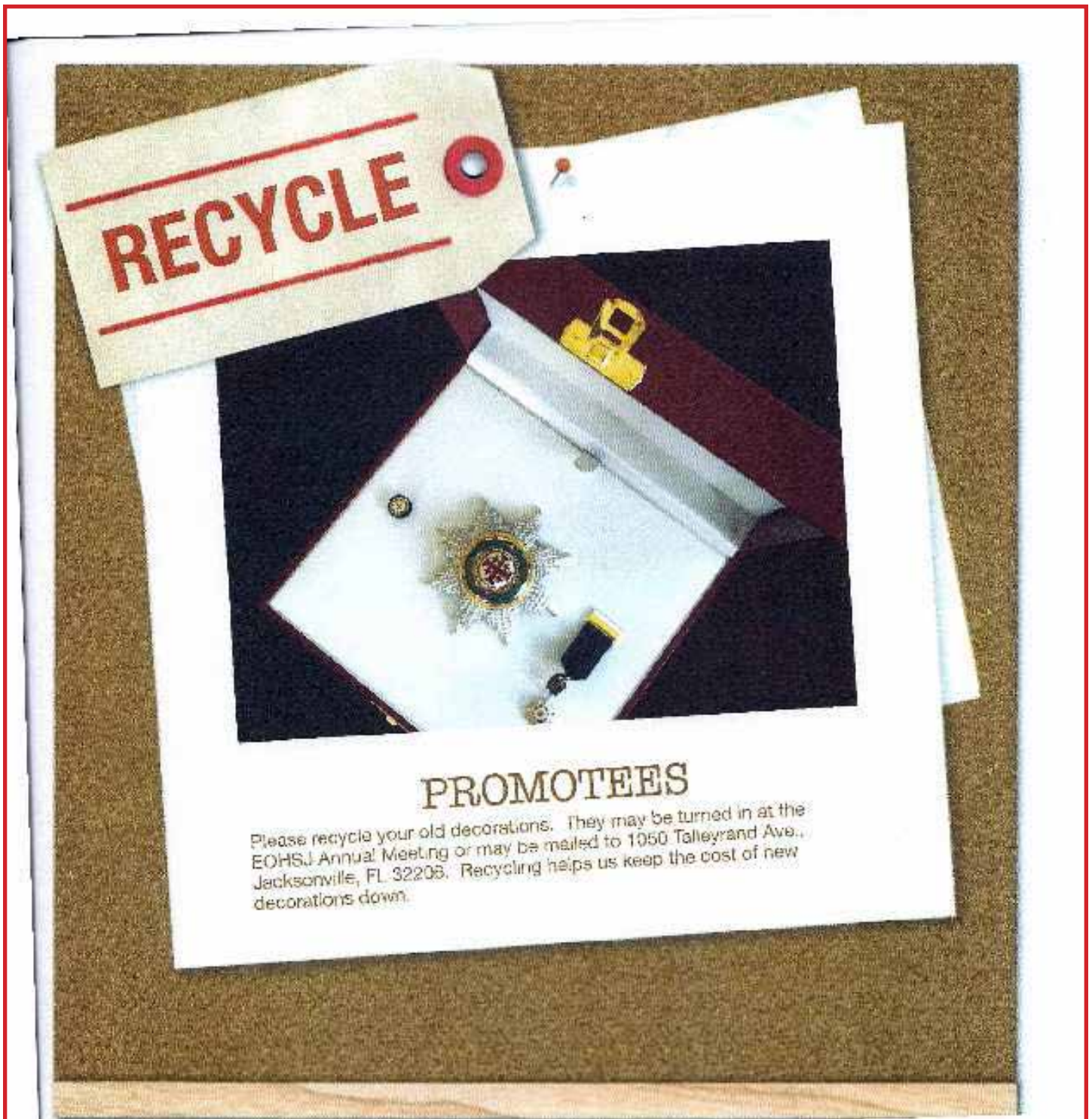

CLOTHING EMBROIDERED WITH THE JERUSALEM CROSS

To see the many clothing items available, go to www.landsend.com. At the bottom of the home page, click on "Business Outfitters." At the top of the Business Outfitters page, make your selection by category. Or, you can order a catalog at (800) 338-2000. Remember, however, that only the items offered by the Business Outfitters Department can be embroidered with the Jerusalem Cross, not items in the general catalog although some may be identical. There is an embroidery fee.

When you place your order, you will need the Jerusalem Cross Registration Number which is 0353544. (Have the representative verify that this is the Jerusalem Cross.) You will also need a Customer Number which will be assigned to you when you place your first order and, in the future, will identify you with the Jerusalem Cross. If you forget your Customer Number after your first order you can also be located by your name and zip code.

The Jerusalem Cross from Lands' End is only to be used by members of the Order and the Registration Number must not be given to non-members. The Southeastern Lieutenancy receives no benefit from the registration of the Jerusalem Cross or from any embroidered clothing. This information is provided only to let you know of another way to display the Jerusalem Cross.

We are informed, by the Governor General, that there will be a pilgrimage to Rome September 12-16, 2013. This pilgrimage will follow the Consulta, a meeting of all lieutenants throughout the world, that will be held from September 10-12, 2013. All members of the Order, their spouses and relatives are invited to attend and to take part in the pilgrimage. The pilgrimage will include, among other events, a visit to the four Papal Basilicas (with a mass in St. Peter's Basilica) as well as the attendance, on Sunday September 15, at the Angelus presided by His Holiness Benedict XVI in the summer residence in Castel Gandolfo.

The Grand Magisterium has booked some three and four star hotels in Rome to accommodate the pilgrims. (In keeping with the intent of the nature of a pilgrimage there are no luxury hotels reserved). The hotels that are reserved will provide full board, some wine, water and soft drinks inclusive in their rates. We are informed that transportation to and from the airport and to the various locations in the pilgrimage are included in the hotel rates as well. The rates are as follows:

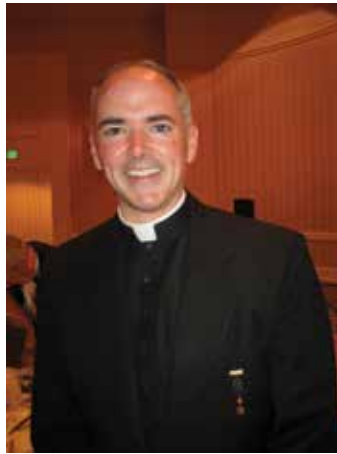
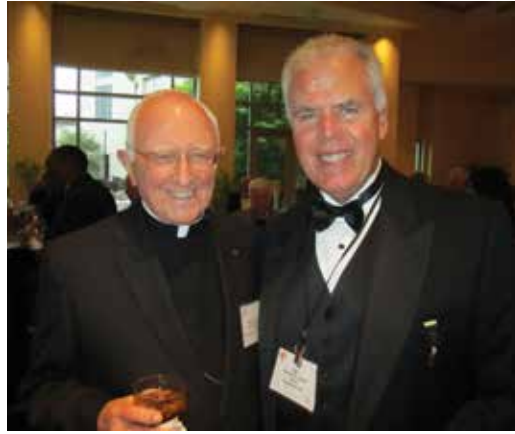
For 5 days and four nights, September 12th and departure on September 16, double occupancy four star hotel €777 per person; €1057 single. Three star hotel €656 per person; €792 single.

This might be an excellent opportunity to combine the pilgrimage with a visit elsewhere in Italy perhaps to Assisi, Padua, Venice and/or Florence.

We have been urged to get our reservations in prior to October 15, 2012 and to be sure that we can obtain accommodations at the booked hotels and that all our members are in the same hotel. They will be taking reservations from the Lieutenants as they are received.

There is to be a separate list of reservations for each category of hotel, four star and three star for each lieutenancy.

HOLY LAND PILGRIMAGE FEBRUARY 1-11, 2013

The Equestrian Order of The Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem, Southeastern Lieutenancy, is offering a pilgrimage to the Holy Land for the period of February 1-11, 2013 at a cost of \$3299 per person, double occupancy. The trip departs JFK, New York, non-stop to Tel Aviv and includes first class hotels, private motor coach transportation, breakfast and dinner and all fees and taxes. Upon arrival in Tel Aviv, we will be met by Fr. Peter Vasko, O.F.M., and President of the Franciscan Foundation for the Holy Land who will be our spiritual leader throughout the trip. Fr. Peter has lived in Jerusalem for the past 26 years and is internationally known for his work in the Holy Land.
