HOLY LAND PILGRIMAGE NOVEMBER 1-11, 2014

Our Lieutenancy's November 2014 pilgrimage to the Holy Land included 17 pilgrims. Fr. Peter Vasko, O.F.M., served as our spiritual leader throughout the trip. He is the founder and president of the Franciscan Foundation Holy Land, and has resided in the Holy Land for the past 29 years. We had at one point 31 pilgrims signed up, but due to the events in Gaza during the summer months, cancellations resulted in our lower number. It is important to note that our pilgrimage encountered no security issues, interruptions, or any other personal security concerns during the entire time we were in the Holy Land. What we did encounter were record crowds of pilgrims at every Holy site visited, evidence of the return to normalcy following the events in Gaza.

Our group was received on Friday, November 7th, by His Beatitude, Most Reverend Fouad Twal, the Latin Patriarch of Jerusalem. His Beatitude awarded 5 Pilgrim Shells to four Knights and one Lady making their first pilgrimage to the Holy Land. Following the ceremony, group pictures were taken and a brief reception for the group was hosted by the Latin Patriarch affording each an opportunity to visit with him.

A later Pilgrimage to the Holy Land took place February 4-14, 2015. A full report was not available at the time of the publication of this Newsletter. 












Recycle Your Unused Ornaments
